FEATURES

INDICATIONS FOR USE


The prophy paste is thixotropic: if desired, the fluidity of the paste can be increased by gentle spatulation before use. Replace lid after use. For best results use with prophy type handpiece and cup/brush combination.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Fill cup/brush with paste and run at low speed over each tooth surface, making sure that the edge of the cup/brush goes below the free margin of the gingival sulcus. Repeat this procedure for each tooth until all exposed surfaces have been treated. Unwaxed Dental Floss may be used to remove any excess paste through interproximal areas.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Replace lid after use. Store in cool, dry conditions.



Do not reuse empty packaging.
